

Cleaning guidelines

Disinfection

Regular basic hygiene such as cleaning and disinfection of all areas of the practice including “Multi touch areas” and daily equipment/materials used such as uniforms and equipment.

Multi-Touch Areas

- Door handles – including external doors
- Light Switches
- Electrical Equipment i.e.: kettle / microwave / card machine
- Computer keyboards
- Computer mice
- Telephones
- Chair backs
- Desks
- Customer information / leaflets
- Fridge handles

This is not an exhaustive list

Client literature and magazine in waiting areas to be reduced or removed

High Footfall areas

- Reception & seating areas
- Consult rooms
- Public toilet

High footfall areas need to be cleaned 3 times a day where feasible and possible, or after a suspected cause of concern.
