Member Guidelines

These guidelines are here to support you as members and WLTSC team to keep us safe. Do not visit if you are exhibiting any symptoms of the Coronavirus or have been in contact with anyone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

- Entry is via the double doors in the conservatory
- On entry please record your name on the sheet provided for governance/track & trace
- Sanitiser is available on entry and we encourage you to use it
- Please follow the one way system in place that is clearly marked on the floor
- When ordering at the bar you will be approx. 2m from the barperson
- There is a screen between yourself and the bar person
- Payment will be via contactless or cash (a sanitised tray will be used for cash payments)
- Your drinks will be placed on the opposite side of the bar for you to collect. Food will be delivered to your table
- Do not congregate at the bar area
- The option to sit inside is clearly marked
 - On the floor
 - On tables
 - All furniture has been positioned to comply with social distancing. **Furniture cannot be moved under any circumstances.**
- To order additional food or drinks please wait until there is a space to approach the bar
- Children are more than welcome, however parents/guardians are wholly responsible for ensuring they adhere to social distancing regulations.
- Toilets have a social distance que system in place
- Toilets can only accommodate one person at a time. Hand washing is essential, and we ask that customers spray all contact areas with sanitising spray (provided) before exit.
- Avoid touching multitouch and communal zones if you can
- Other parts of the clubhouse are restricted
- Return glasses to glass collection point
- Exit at the conservatory single door. Please use your discretion as members use the stairs.
