

First Resolution

Explanation

At the moment people in a wheelchair or have difficulty with steps cannot go on the main floor of the club. We are one of the very few places in Wolverhampton where this is not possible. As well as been discriminatory, we are losing functions, restaurant revenue and social memberships because we don't have this.

Three years ago the club was given a legacy of £100,000 which was to be spent on disabled access as well as development of the club. Disabled access has been slowed down as it was to be part of the Fill the Gap Project.

Whilst there is not a straightforward option there are a number of ways that access can be gained from the front and back of the club. The Committee are asked to proceed immediately in getting disabled access to the Bar and Restaurant.
